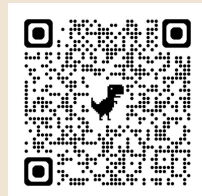

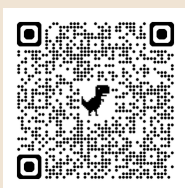
Disciplinary Protections for Students with Disabilities

This guidebook shares information on what to do when the school imposes disciplinary measures, such as suspensions or changes of placement, on students with behavior-related disabilities.



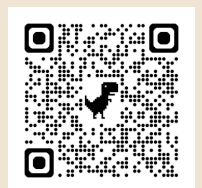
Fall 2025 Changes to Graduation Pathways in New Mexico

Did you know that the Modified Graduation Pathway is being phased out? Learn about the changes here and what to ask in your student's next IEP meeting.



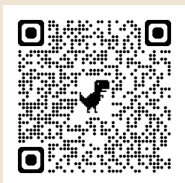
Transition Services for Youth 14+ Years Old
